Lesson Plan for Music and Art Lesson (4-8) (Melody)

Summary

- O In this lesson student will demonstrate understanding of a "Jazz Great". They will accomplish this by researching a "Jazz Great".

5. Write a poem to go with music and art (M) (http://www.google.com) Google Docs


6. Find some photos or art on the web (E) (http://www.google.com)
